Old Town, Bordeaux

Outside Cambes, Garonne River

04 *Ile De La Lande*



Île de la Lande

The Nazis use the labyrinthine tunnels and dungeons to torture their victims. Who does Garonne have to rescue from this deadly castle?




08 Pont de Langoiran

Castets-en-Dorthe

The Garonne Canal starts at Castets-en-Dorthe. It snakes its way through the countryside towards Toulouse, where the clandestine Comet Line, a network of safe houses and escape routes, helps countless refugees flee Nazi-occupied France.



What happens when Garonne delivers his crew to Castets-en-Dorthe and how does it change Garonne's life?
